Safety First:

- 1) Treat All Guns as Loaded!**
- 2) Never point the muzzle of any firearm toward anything you do not wish to destroy.**
- 3) Keep trigger finger outside trigger well and on something solid until sights indexed on target and decision to shoot has been made.**
- 4) Know your target and what lies behind it.**

May - Points to Ponder **Dry Fire & Engaging Threats Thru Doorways**

- **Dry Fire Exercises are a great, free way to practice**
 - **Smoothing Draw from Holster**
 - **Acquiring Sight Picture – Speed**
 - **Trigger Press**
 - **Eliminating Tendency toward Shooter Errors**
 - **Anticipation of Recoil**
 - **Inducing Recoil**
 - **Milking**
- **Make sure gun is completely unloaded**
 - **Remove magazine**
 - **Clear Chamber**
- **Make a dry run through the course of fire prior to shooting the exercise**
- **Engage targets as you come around doorways rather than exposing yourself completely**
- **Keep muzzle pointed downrange when moving right or leftward**
- **No ammo in gun until “Load & Make Ready” command is given**
- **Reload behind cover/concealment for defensive situations**
